

Information morphic theory and hilomorphic theory: ancient philosophical dilemmas in the mirror of contemporaneity

The reflection seeks to discuss how, in Antiquity, the birth of Greek philosophy develops a central debate for what in the future we would call information theory. The research has as its structure the logological philosophy, which is oriented towards the rhetorical revolution in the ancient world. The central issues under debate start from the trivium: fundamentally from logic and rhetoric, and from the problems of truth in the city. Concepts of actual information theory such as fixation, proliferation, power, surveillance, fake news, citizenship, pandemic, politics are explored. As a horizon, the proposal discusses the cultural and social gap opened by rhetoric in Antiquity.
